But what if Spring was never to come. What if, because of some astronomical disaster, we all were caught in the grip of a winter that would not let go, and the earth remained dark, cold, wet, and barren. Yes, in order to get to the glorious resurrection we must journey through Holy Week, the Last Supper and the Crucifixion. Difficult stuff to be sure. But where would we be without it? 
